introduction

This user manual provides detailed instructions for the Redragon H848 wireless gaming headset. It covers setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The H848 offers multiple connectivity options with 2.4GHz wireless, and wired USB-C modes, and delivers 7.1 surround sound through 40mm drivers for an immersive audio experience.

Connecting the microphone

Insert the detachable microphone into its designated port on the left earcup until you hear a click when it is securely fastened. Ensure it is properly connected for clear sound.

Connection modes

The Redragon H848 supports: 2.4GHz wireless, and wired (USB-C).

2.4GHz wireless connection (recommended for PC/PlayStation 5/PlayStation 4/PlayStation 3/Switch)

1. Connect the 2.4GHz wireless USB device to an available USB port on your device (PC, PlayStation, Nintendo Switch dock).
2. Turn on the headset. The headset will automatically attempt to connect to the wireless device.
3. Once connected, the indicator light on the headset will stabilize, and you will hear the voice message "Game mode, power on".

4. Make sure the headset is selected as an audio input and output device in the system settings.

Wired connection to USB-C port (recommended for PC/PlayStation 5/PlayStation 4/PlayStation 3/Switch)

1. Connect the USB-C cable to the USB-C port on your headset, and the other end to a USB port on your device.
2. The headset will automatically switch to wired connection mode. The headset indicator will light up red and blue.
3. Make sure the headset is selected as an audio input and output device in the system settings.

volume control :

Adjust the volume level using the volume up (+) and volume down (-) buttons located on the earphone.

Mute/Unmute Microphone

press the microphone mute button to turn it on or off. A red indicator light on the microphone or headset may show that it is muted.

Sound features

The H848 headphones feature 7.1 surround sound technology for an immersive audio experience. This feature is automatically activated when connected via a 2.4 GHz wireless network or a wired USB-C port. The 40 mm drivers deliver a wide frequency range and rich soundstages.

Battery life

The headphones offer a battery life of 20 to 25 hours on a full charge. They automatically power off after 10 minutes if not connected to a transmitter or if no audio source is present when connected.
